Rating of Mandala Finance's maturing bond is affirmed at "idA"

PEFINDO has affirmed its "idA" rating to PT Mandala Multifinance Tbk (Mandala Finance)'s Shelf-Registration Bond III Phase III/2019 Series A of IDR103 billion that will mature on September 7, 2020. The Company's readiness to repay its maturing bond is supported by its cash and cash equivalents of IDR407 billion at the end of June 2020.

Debt security rated idA indicates that the obligor's capacity to meet its long-term financial commitments on the debt security, relative to other Indonesian obligors, is strong, however, the debt security is somewhat more susceptible to adverse effects of changes in circumstances and economic conditions than higher-rated debt.

Mandala Finance focuses on new and used motorcycle financing. Its ultimate major shareholder, PT Jayamandiri Gemasejati, and its affiliate, PT Lautan Teduh Interniaga, hold the Yamaha dealerships in West Java and Lampung, respectively. However, the Company's business is not solely focused on Yamaha motorcycles, as it also provides financing for other brands, such as Honda and Suzuki. As of March 31, 2020, its shareholders were PT Jayamandiri Gemasejati (70.42%), Alex Hendrawan (5.06%), and the public (24.52%).
